employment service, NGOs, municipalities, migrants – participants in the


Slovenian language course.

Content:

Findings and Recommendations:

- Voluntary work must be organised.
- There is a great need for voluntary work but insufficient cooperation between different organisations.
- There is less funding for integration policies, making the integration of volunteers into working with immigrants very important for facilitating the integration of the latter into the local environment.
- A successful integration of immigrants requires cooperation and integration of different organisations in the local environment – an initiative to participate in project activities of various organisations.
